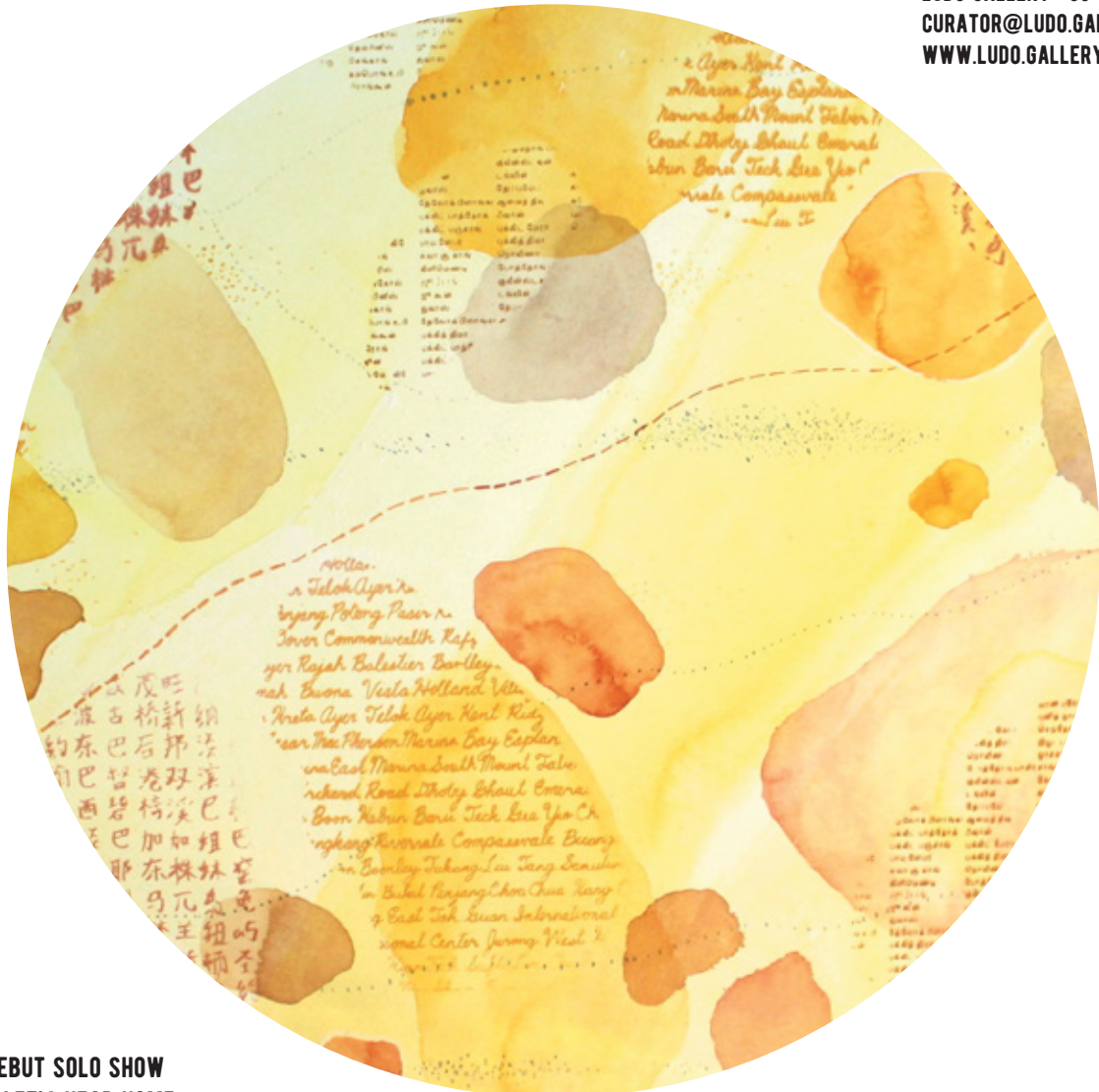

**JENNIFER LIM DEBUT SOLO SHOW  
BALIK RUMAH – LET’S HEAD HOME**

**23 OCTOBER – 15 NOVEMBER 2015  
LUDO GALLERY**

Australian-Peranakan artist Jennifer Lim will open her first solo show at Ludo Gallery in the Waterloo Centre, on Friday October 23.

Balik Rumah - Let's Head Home will feature new prints and paintings incorporating local motifs, languages and geographic references. Influenced by her cross-cultural experiences and the notion of 'home', Jennifer has created a stunning installation of nearly 600 miniature handmade prints spelling out the title of the show.

Born to an Australian mother and Singaporean Peranakan father, Jennifer spent her early years in Sydney and graduated in Visual Arts (1st Class Honours) and Asian Studies from the Australian National University.

After working as a translator in Japan for over five years, she has since made Singapore her new 'home'. Jennifer has restarted her art career - spurred on by her father's recent loss of memory.

"Our link to the past is so fragile - recording one's family history is a gift for the next generation", says Jennifer.

This interest in her ancestry has motivated Jennifer to learn more about her Peranakan roots, which is reflected in her recent body of work.

Balik Rumah - Let's Head Home coincides with the first-ever Peranakan Arts Festival, where Jennifer has been invited to demonstrate her skills in the 400-year-old printing technique of Japanese woodblock.

Selected audience members will have the chance to print Peranakan themed woodblocks created especially for the Festival.
